

What has the ISEZ Land Mobilisation Team accomplished so far?



We are now into Phase 2: (Gates 3&4)

- An inspection flyover of the ISEZ Physical Planning Zone was carried out in April 2023 by senior DLPP Physical Planning officers. All necessary document for submission to the National Physical Planning Board now ready to be submitted. ISEZ hopes to obtain its Physical Planning Area Permit before the end of December 2023.
- Free Prior Informed Consent (FPIC) completed. 10x local Community Liaison officers now engaged after completing of the FPIC process. Analysis of all data collected indicated 85% of the Project area people welcomes the project.
- Kogun Consultancy Limited (KCL) and its Team of professionals was deployed to the Field on the 13th August 2023 after carrying intensive researches with the National Achieves and the Dept. of Lands. The team carried out preliminary studies on sample baseline surveys, social mapping, cultural heritage studies and identification of the various types of Landholdings currently existing within the project area. Further in-depth studies to commence after submission of a preliminary report.
- Environmental Impact Survey contract documents all prepared and awarded to KMK Consultants. Signing of the contract yet to be done before deployment of the Environmental team to the Field,.

- Land Access, Benefits Agreements and Acquisition to pave way for early works Mid 2024
